Import to Iceland

- Vehicle must be booked prior to delivery at harbour. Information on how to book and where to deliver can be found on our website <http://www.eimskip.com>
- Vehicles arriving with the vessels to Reykjavík on Monday can be delivered on Tuesday and the vehicles arriving on Tuesday can be delivered on Wednesday. This depends though on the Icelandic custome. They can delay delivery due to inspection which they can make any time they want.

- vessels arrives in Reykjavík Tuesdays
- vessels arrives in Reykjavík Mondays
- vessels arrives in Reykjavík every other Thursday, this vessel is though often ahead of schedule and is usually in Reykjavík on Wednesday.

- Documents that need to follow the car are:
 - valid insurance certificate
 - copy of registration certfcate (title)
- When vehicle is deliverd to Eimskip's harbor the keys should be left with Eimskip's employee and when loaded the keys are kept in an envelope inside the car.
- Before the vehicle can be released a declatration for temporary duty free importation of a motor vehicle must have been signed. **In order to ensure a quick and reliable handling it is necessary to bring a copy of registration papers and insurance certificate.** Remember to have the originals available.
- The vehicle is released when all requirements have been met. Customer will get a sticker for the car showing the valid period for the licence to drive in Iceland.
- The office hours at Eimskip in Reykjavík are between 8:00 – 16:00 every working day.
- Opening hours at the Customes office is between 8:00 – 15:30 every working day.
- It is **not** possible to get vehicles deliverd out off previously mentioned opening hours.
- Other useful information
 - If the tourists are bringing food they have to carry it in their luggage. If a touristcar with foodstuff is to be shipped to Iceland, the car must be on one B/L and the foodstuff must be on another B/L. Trailer must also be on different B/L as well.
 - Each person is permitted to bring 3 kg. of food in to the country. If that person doesn't take this food with her by flight but sends it with car, the Customs in Keflavik must be notified at arrival. The Customs in Keflavik will provide a statement that there is no food in luggage. This statement must be shown at Customs in Reykjavik when customs clearing the car.
 - If tourist is bringing food in the car, it must be Customs cleared. The shipper (tourist) must have invoices for all the food in the car.
 - The cost for customs entry is EUR 40, in addition is taxifare EUR 40,- (to deliver the customs entry to Customs). VAT depends on the value of the foodstuff + freight. All

together charges will be collected in Iceland. It can take approx. 24 - 36 hours, from the customs entry is received at Customs till Eimskip can release the cargo.
